As you know, our pond fountains had been shut off due to the low water level and concern about damaging the new fountains, They are now running four hours per day to comply with restrictions set by DeSoto County and the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD). The board will adjust the schedule if the restrictions change. These restrictions are currently effective until July 1, 2026.

Pond grasses and weeds remain problematic. The committee has asked our water management provider to recommend which vegetation should be removed while preserving shoreline soil to minimize erosion. This effort is ongoing.
